ARB 1510 Beginning Arabic I 4 Credit Hours

ESL Placement Level: For English-as-a-Second-Language (ESL) students, placement in ESL 2520.

This is an introductory course with special emphasis on the fundamentals of speaking, listening, reading, writing and understanding Arabic language and culture. The course will emphasize the fundamentals of speaking, listening, reading, writing and understanding of Arabic language and culture according to functional models, which can be applied to everyday conversational situations.
